

Chapter Remittance Guidelines
Steps To “ESP...Excellent Scholarly Performance”Examples:

Example: A ten (10) member Graduate Chapter

Bronze	= \$ 100
Silver	= \$ 100
Gold	= \$ 500
Platinum	= <u>\$1,000</u>
Total	= \$1,700 (This is the least that can be submitted for the Platinum level)

Example: A ten (10) member Undergraduate Chapter

Bronze	= \$ 100
Silver	= \$ 25
Gold	= \$ 500
Platinum	= <u>\$ 500</u>
Total	= \$1,125 (This is the least that can be submitted for the Platinum level)

Chapter Contribution Guide	
<u>Graduate</u>	
(Silver Level)	
50 members or less	\$100
51-100 members	\$200
101-150 members	\$300
151-200 members	\$400
201 plus members	\$500

Chapter Contribution Guide	
<u>Undergraduate</u>	
(Silver Level)	
1-10 members	\$25
11-25 members	\$50
26-50 members	\$100
51 plus members	\$150

**Dollars over the minimum in any one level may not be enough to lift you to the next level:
 (Using the same 10 member chapter)**

= Bronze Level Total \$ 100

= Silver Level Total \$ 100

= Gold Level Total \$1,000 (You have a \$1,000 Woman of ESP, half (\$500) would make you a Gold Chapter, yet not enough to move you to Platinum)

= Platinum Level Total \$ 000

Total Enclosed \$1,200 (This would be counted as an \$1,100 Gold Chapter, the \$100 submitted as dues—Bronze—is not counted in the cumulative totals for levels. This chapter would need an additional \$500 to become Platinum)
